Work Integrated Learning Opportunities

Category 1: Applicants who have completed their theoretical part of their qualification can apply for an internship position by using the relevant indicated reference number above. However, should the application be unsuccessful, it will be considered for WIL on a voluntary basis.

REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must be between the ages of 18 – 35 years, South African citizen; unemployed graduates who have never participated in an internship programme or students that require Experiential Training to complete their qualifications. Successful candidates for an internship position will be expected to sign an Internship Agreement and they will receive a monthly allowance or stipend which will be determined by the exit level of their qualifications. Applicants considered for WIL on a voluntary basis will be expected to sign an indemnity form.

Applications must be submitted on a signed new Z83 form, obtained from any Public Service Department, and Curriculum Vitae, plus certified copies of Identity Document, Senior Certificate & qualification, including academic transcript.
